Build Your Pet Emergency Supply Kit:

- Three-day supply (minimum) of food and water per pet
 - Moist canned food will keep your pet hydrated longer and will help conserve your water supply
 - Pack dry food in an airtight container
- Bowls
- Manual can opener
- Litter box and litter, newspapers, paper towels, garbage bags, or other materials needed to clean up after your pet
- Collar or harness with updated ID tag
- Leash
- Crate or carrier
- Important records in a waterproof bag: registration, adoption papers, vaccination history, microchip number, other medical documents
- Pet first-aid kit and medications
- Current photo of your pet in case you are separated
- Favorite toys, treats, or bedding to help comfort them during a possibly stressful time

To file a claim:

- 1** File a claim online at www.markerinsurance.com or call carrier
- 2** Make any temporary repairs necessary to protect your home and property from further damage, such as general cleanup, placing a tarp over roof damage to prevent leaks, etc. Make sure to save the receipts for anything you purchase.
- 3** Take photos of anything that may need to be disposed of prior to your Adjuster's visit.
- 4** In the event your home is uninhabitable, contact a member of our Claims Department for an explanation of your policy's living expense allowance.
